At Camp Michawana there are many volunteer opportunities to support our Summer Camp Programing. Serving God at camp is a great way to minister while also having fun. There are many options for volunteering at Camp Michawana, these are just some of the options we have available.

Camper Care Specialist: Our campers are our number one priority and Camper Care Specialist is a great position if you like providing support and a little extra love to campers. Camper Care Specialists work alongside our counselors for any camper who may need extra love, care, or attention. We'd be looking for someone who has experience working with kids and handling discipline. This position is best for volunteers who are willing/wanting to stay for a full week.

Craft/Creation Cabin: Are you crafty? Do you like teaching kids about God's creation? If you do the craft and creation cabins might be an area where you would like to serve. The craft is open at the same time as the trading post So this position is best for volunteers who are willing/wanting to stay for a full week.

Kitchen: Feeding averagely 140 campers each week can be a very tough task to accomplish but our kitchen staff always pulls through. The kitchen is a great place to lend a hand especially if you have experience working in a kitchen or if you're a fast learner. So this position is best for volunteers who are willing/wanting to stay for a full week. (s).

Office Work: There's lots of paper work that has to get done for our campers, either before they arrive or after they leave. Weather that is stapling log books or inputting bible buddy forms into our system. If you like some less strenuous work the office would be a great place for you to check out. The times that you can work can also be very flexible too. So get in contact with the Volunteer Coordinator for more specific times.

Trading Post: The camp store is where campers come daily to get their fill of candy and goodies. This is a good position for people who are looking for an active area to work. The store is open 2-5:30 Monday –Thursday. The kids love the store and it takes lots of hands for the store to run smoothly. This position is best for volunteers who are willing/wanting to stay for a full week.

Boat Driving: Do you like diving a boat weather that be a speed boat or a pontoon boat. We have several opportunities for boat driving here at camp. We take all campers tubing at least once a week... That's a lot of tubing. We have two speed boats but that means we need two drivers in order to take them out each day. We will also take campers out on the pontoon boat and take them on a creation hike. If you are 24 or older get in contact with the Volunteer Coordinator for specifics on times for boat driving

Maintenance: Just like the office there is always maintenance work to be done around camp, but unlike the office maintenance requires a certain set of particular skills. If you like building or fixing things maintenance might just be the area for you. We can let you know certain projects that we are working on to see if you think you can lend a hand. Projects can range anywhere from painting cabin, building, repairing, or even bee hive removal. Lots of exciting projects that our maintenance crew handles.
