SUMMER IS HERE! We're preparing for our largest summer on record and we're on track for over 800 campers plus 300 Family Campers! We have 17 girl counselors, 12 guy counselors, and 10 event staff. In addition to our regular staff we have 7 RV programming staff!

Everyone from toddlers to grandparents biked with a 6-1 ratio of donors to riders! So far over \$25,000 was given! The average scholarship is \$142 per camper; which means nearly 200 kids will be able to come thanks to the gifts from Michawana Bike!
