GUYANA TRIP 2022

We're sending a team back to Guyana, South America to help kick off their Summer Camp!

Last August, a team of eight CM staff partnered with eight staff from Word of Life (FL) to train and show an example of how a Christian summer camp operates. We facilitated training, chapels, games, and cabin groups so the local Guyanese pastors and youth leaders could learn then copy us. The campers LOVED it and their volunteers were grateful for the energy and planning we brought. Staff and campers had never been to a camp and didn't know what to expect, how to schedule it, or know that they could memorize 15 verses in one week while chanting together!

Since August, the Association of Bible Churches in Guyana has finished the cabins, built an activity center, and are installing a pool. A camp like this seems small to us (less than 2 acres total size). Camps are unheard of in Berbice County, Guyana. The plan is for our team of 6+ to kick off their summer camps beginning July 10-16 by teaming up with their counselors (church volunteers) and getting things rolling. We will be taking our 'Off the Wall" curriculum, log books, and games and modifying them for camp near the equator in the only English speaking country in South America!
